To persons interested in becoming a registered Concealed Handgun Carry License Firearms Safety Training Instructor with the Arkansas State Police:

Attached you will find the following:

1. Firearm Safety Training Instructor Registration application form;
2. Applicable Arkansas Code Sections (as amended through 07/2007);
3. Arkansas State Police Rules and Procedures (effective January 1, 2009); and
5. Appropriate fingerprint cards.

Testing Information

Applicants must score at least eighty percent (80%) or higher on the Firearm Safety Training Instructor Registration examination.

Everything in the Rules and the Arkansas law as outlined in the Instructor Training Manual is subject to being tested.

Contact this office twenty-four (24) hours in advance to schedule a test date and time. All testing is conducted at Arkansas State Police Headquarters in Little Rock, Arkansas (I-30 at Geyer Springs Road, exit 133).

When you are ready to schedule a test e-mail our office at info@asp.arkansas.gov

You must present the following at the time of testing:

1. A properly completed Firearm Safety Training Instructor Registration application form
2. An Arkansas driver's license;
3. A training certificate qualifications as outlined in ASP rules;
4. Properly-completed legible fingerprint card(s); and
5. A check or money order for \$44.25 (\$25.00 state background check fee and \$19.25 FBI background check fee). Those fees may be waived upon presentment of a valid Arkansas concealed handgun carry license.
